NH exits hospital operations at Hyderabad

Bangalore, India, 5th April, 2016 – Narayana Hrudayalaya Limited, a leading healthcare service provider in India, today announced that it has decided to cease operations at its “Malla Reddy Narayana Multispecialty Hospital” in Hyderabad, Telangana (erstwhile Andhra Pradesh) and entered into an agreement to sell the undertaking to Chandramma Educational Society.

Malla Reddy Narayana Multispecialty Hospital was commissioned in July 2010 in Hyderabad on a 20-year lease with Chandramma Educational Society. This hospital with 195 operational beds reported revenues of Rs 322 mn, representing 2.7% of consolidated operational revenues of Narayana Hrudayalaya Limited, for the nine months period ending December 31st, 2015.

Commenting on the decision, **Dr. Ashutosh Raghuvanshi, Vice Chairman, Managing Director and Group CEO, Narayana Hrudayalaya Limited**, said *“As part of our regular strategic business reviews, we constantly monitor and assess risks and costs associated with all our business units. Conforming to the same and in order to maximize gains for all the stakeholders, we deemed it appropriate to discontinue operations at our Hyderabad unit. We would continue to be flexible and pragmatic in the future as well to sustain the long term interest of the business.”*
